## Thought for the week

***Why are you so afraid?*** Mark 4:40

Fear plays an enormous part in our lives – we do or don't do things based on fear, we can waste hours of our time fretting and we can find so much to be frightened of – personally, or for our family, or out in the world...

Yet in this case, the answer seems obvious. Jesus is asking this of His disciples – but they have just been engulfed in a storm that had overwhelmed their boat and threatened to drown them! Surely they could fear?

We need to note three things. Firstly, Jesus was with them in the boat. Secondly, Jesus had told them to cross this lake – they were sailing under His instructions. And thirdly we must not forget Jesus is God – He has all power and authority!

So let's pause a moment - what are you worrying about? What situations are you involved in where fear is a factor? Now look at those three things – is Jesus with you? (we can be disobedient and we may need to repent ..) What is Jesus saying to you about this situation? (have you asked Him?) And do we recognise the power and authority of God in this situation?

Why are you so afraid?

Finally of course, it's not just us! We must be aware of others' fear too and see this as an evangelistic opportunity....
