People of all ages have heard the gospel, many for the first time, and thousands have responded.

We are not funded by any major denomination or organisation. We offer our services free of charge only asking for costs to cover our expenses. Our ministry is funded by a small group of committed individuals who share our vision of going out and sharing the Good News in a society that has increasingly turned its back on God.

Remembering TFM in your will

Whatever amount you choose to leave TFM your support will enable us to continue and develop our work. Here are a few answers to questions you may have:

Why should I have a will? Making a will is the best way to ensure that your money goes to the people you want it to. In some circumstances it can make financial sense as charitable gifts can be exempt from inheritance tax.

How do I make a will? Contact your solicitor or legal adviser who, for a small fee, will advise you and draw up your will. They can give advice on the different ways of leaving a legacy such as a share of what is left in your estate after all your other wishes have been met, a specific sum of money or a specific bequest of an item of value. Make sure your solicitor includes our full details including our address and registered charity no. 801113.

Can I change my existing will? Yes, if you already have a will your solicitor or legal adviser can assist you in filling out a short form called a codicil allowing you to make changes to your existing will.
